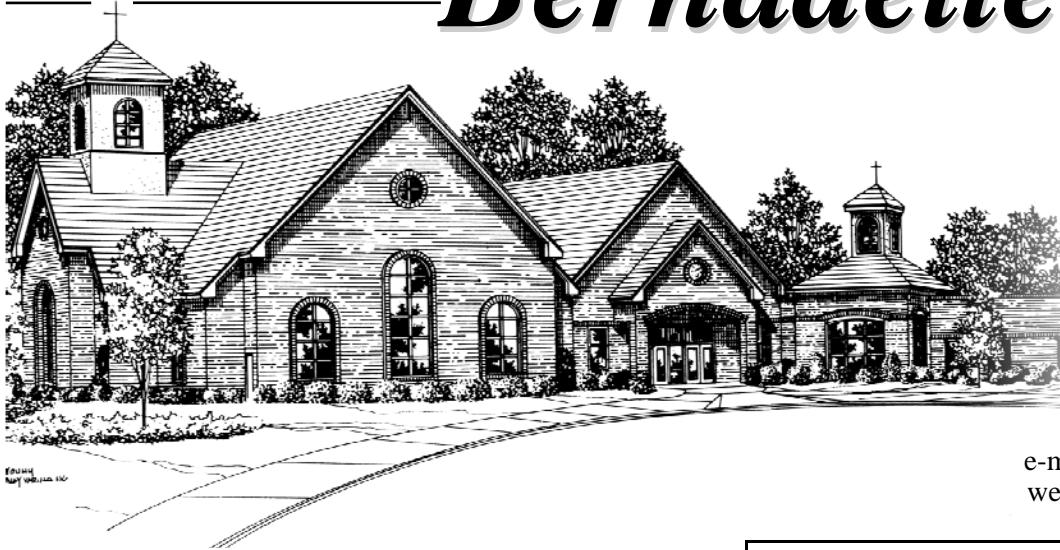

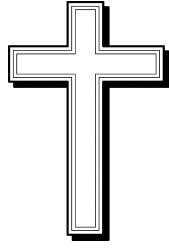

Preparemos nuestro espíritu esta época de recogimiento espiritual estudiando los textos sagrados. Los cursos serán impartidos por el P. Chesco.



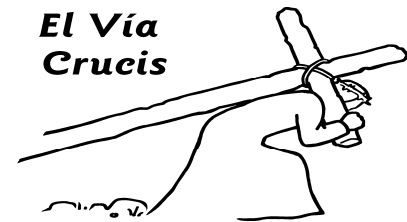
40 DÍAS POR LA VIDA
